IndexingLunarBibles **A description of how the Bibles are indexed.**

Packets were made flight ready by placing a thin piece of tissue between each twenty Bibles. After the flight the tissue a piece of wax paper marked the unit. The entire stack is then indexed from 14-000 to 14-099. They are all there is in the lunar module packet . There is not room for any other Bibles. Jimmy had the illusion that I gave him twelve other Bibles. That can't be, because there are only 100 in the lunar module packet.

Jimmy has lived in illusions all of his life, from early childhood, by being bitten by a snake, by a dog. By claiming he weighed 13.7 pounds, when he really weighed only 6 pounds, claiming he had the same doctor. stealing my birthright, that is I weighed 13.7 pounds. Jimmy doesn't even remember how many wives he has had.

Mitchell had already certified to Helen Green of Knoxville TN that I was totally responsible for the disposition of all of the Bibles. Mitchell certification is out of step with his statement to Green. Even so why would Mitchell certify items that never went to the moon. The only thing that Jimmy can show of anything that went to the moon was a part of the lander that Mitchell brought back to earth.

My father was a very benevolent man. He gave \$25,000 to the Temple Baptist Church, \$10,000 to the Handley Baptist church, Paid his own way as a clown for the Shiners Cripple Children's Hospital in Galveston. Further Jimmy has been restricted from owning any of the Bibles related to the Apollo 14 mission.
